

Standardized Tests

Both the Educational Testing Service (ETS) and College Outcomes offer tests of students' cumulative knowledge from their major field of study, which ETS calls "major field tests" and College Outcomes calls "area concentration achievement tests" (ACATs). These tests provide students' individual scores reflecting their overall performance in the discipline as well as sub-scores reflecting their knowledge of sub-disciplines within the field. National norms are provided so that faculty can benchmark their students' performance.
