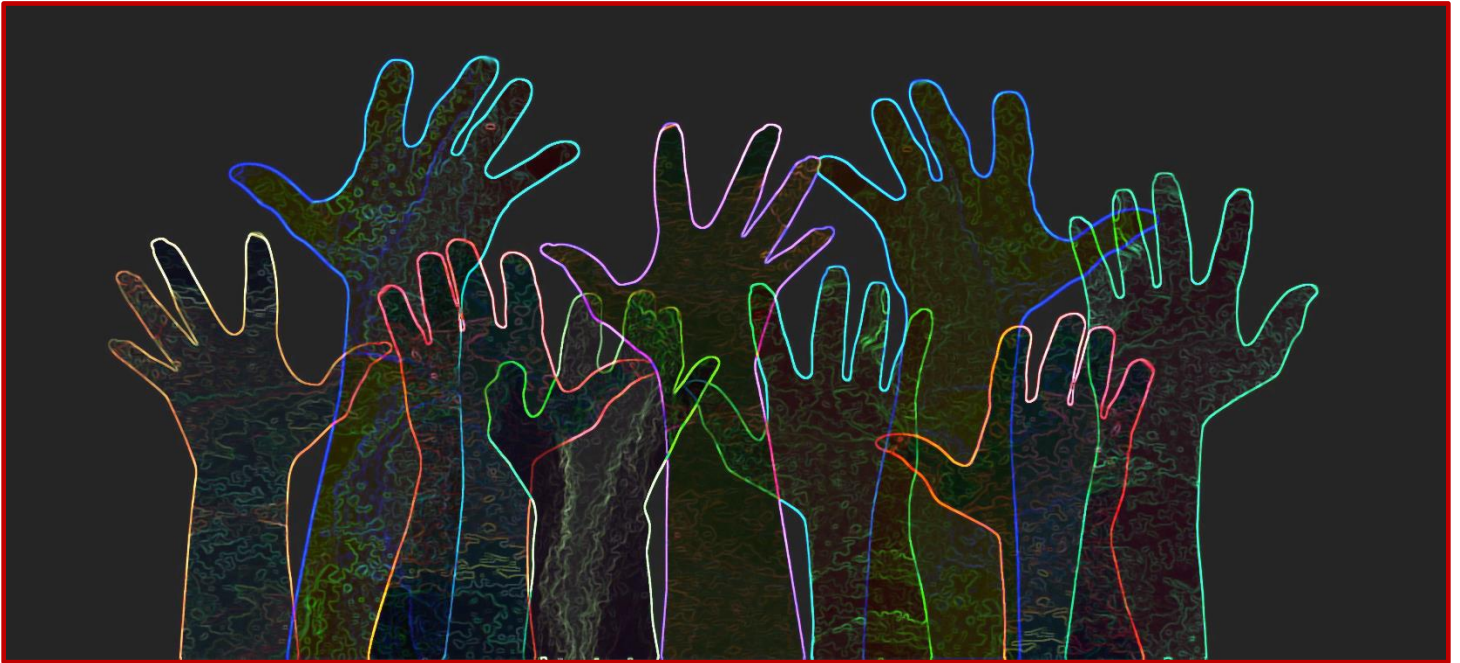


# WORKSHOP *on* WORKPLACE DIVERSITY
