

## You are about to embark on the academic journey of a lifetime

But first – there are some things to keep in mind. *Rules of the road:*

- Fill out the application form front and back
- Counselor and parent signatures **are required**
- Students with cumulative GPAs between 2.7 and 3.0 need to show an 1100+ on their SAT, PSAT, or a 24+ on their ACT
- Home-school students must show SAT or PSAT of 1100 or higher along with home-school transcripts
- Students on free & reduced lunch at their schools qualify for EWU's book loan program
- Initial advising and registration sessions are assigned in the order that applications are received
- If you no-show no-call your initial advising session, you will be put in the last initial advising session – this may impact the schedule you secure for your first term
- Omission of any information on the application will delay processing
- Must take EWU math placement test or have college or AP credit for placement into math classes
- Must take EWU English placement test, have college or AP credit, or have SAT score for placement into English composition classes
- Bring the completed application and grad plan for your high school to your counselor for review
- High school transcripts must include grades for first semester of 10th grade.
- Submit your completed grad plan, completed application, transcripts, and (if necessary) test scores to EWU's Running Start Office. Copies are acceptable, pictures taken from a phone are not - all information must be readable. Documents with incomplete or unreadable information will be returned before processing.
- Applications deadline is June 15th except in very special circumstances. *Turning in an application after June 15<sup>th</sup> will limit your class choices.*
