Effective July 24, 2015, in conjunction with the federal Veterans Access, Choice, and Accountability Act of 2014, Washington State law allows veterans to pay the resident tuition rate. Effective May 4, 2017, it includes spouses and children that are entitled to transferred post-9/11 educational benefits from active duty military persons that are stationed outside the state of Washington. To qualify students must complete this declaration if they meet the following requirements (check which applies):

I am a veteran who:

- separated under honorable conditions after at least ninety days of active service; and
- is eligible for Federal VA Educational Benefits; and
- is entering an institution of higher education in Washington within three years of the date of discharge of service

(Please attach your DD-214 and supporting documentation verifying you now live in Washington state.)

(If Washington is your official home of record; or if you moved to Washington and established a domicile as determined on RCW 28B.15.013, go to www.ewu.edu/residency and complete the Washington Uniform Residency Questionnaire. Return that Questionnaire to Records and Registration Office, 201 Sutton Hall, Cheney, WA, in lieu of completing this form.)

I am the spouse or child:

- of an individual who separated under honorable conditions after at least ninety days of active duty service; and
- is eligible for Federal VA Educational Benefits; and
- is entering an institution of higher education in Washington within three years of the date of discharge of service or death in the line of duty of service member.

(Please attach service member's DD-214 and supporting documentation verifying you now live in Washington state.)

- of an individual who is currently on active duty military stationed outside the state of Washington that has transferred their post-9/11 educational benefits to me.

(Please attach current copy of active duty person's orders and documentation verifying you are their dependent if not on the orders.)

(If Washington is veteran's or active duty person's official home or record; or if Washington is his or her primary domicile as determined in RCW 28B.15.013, go to www.ewu.edu/residency and complete the Washington Uniform Residency Questionnaire. Spouses and children of active duty persons stationed outside the state of Washington: I understand that this exemption to be charged resident tuition will expire July 1, and must be reapplied for before fall term every academic year.
